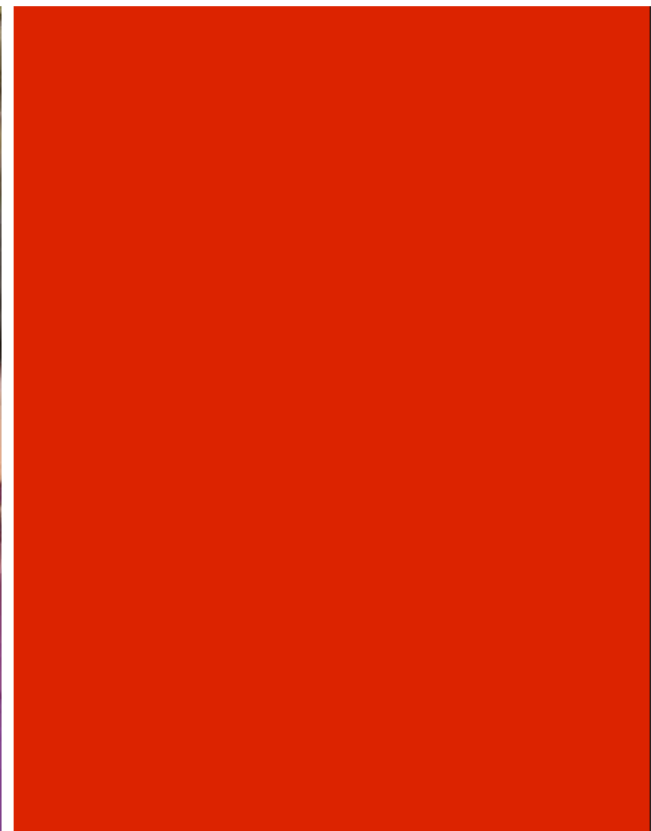
The 'Future Heroes' arrive at the Archbishop Lanfranc School
